## What is an Eventers Challenge?

This is a fun competition run over a show jumping course, which then leads straight on to the Cross Country course. This is not only a test of skill but also endurance, as it will run over a long course. Cross Country colours are worn for the whole competition. The winner will be the combination with least penalties closest to the optimum time.

**Class 1**                    **VERY NOVICE**    **SJ 60cm approx**    **XC 60cm approx**  
Combination must not have been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in any ODE or Cross Country/Hunter Trial. Combination not to have competed higher than 2ft3"

**Class 2**                    **NOVICE**                    **SJ 70cm approx**    **XC 75cm approx**  
Open to any Combination not to have been placed at 2'6 or above

**Class 3**                    **PAIRS**                    **SJ 70cm approx**    **XC 75cm approx**  
Open to any combination. The 1st competitor jumps the SJ's while the other waits in a box, then the 2nd person jumps SJ's before both go onto the xc course together!

**Class 4**                    **INTERMEDIATE**    **SJ:80cm approx.**    **XC: 85cm approx**  
Combination not to have been placed at B.E or B.S affiliated level

**Class 5**                    **OPEN**                    **SJ: 90cm approx**    **XC: 85-90cm approx**  
Open to any combination. There will be an extra Show Jump in the XC Section of the course!

**Trophy to winner and Medals, Rosettes to 6th place, Rosette to Highest Placed RVRC member**

### **RULES AND CONDITIONS:**

- **HARD HATS WITH NO FIXED PEAK** (to BSI standard), body protectors (to BSI standard) and medical armbands **MUST** be worn.
- After 3 refusals at one jump you will be eliminated, you may continue on the course but keep out of the way of other competitors.
- Judges decision is final
- British Riding Club rules will apply.
- Disclaimer of liability- save the death or personal injury caused by negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability whatsoever while upon the showground or while entering or leaving the same, for any death, injury or loss or damage to any competitor or his or her agent or to any animal, article, plant, machinery or thing bought on to the showground or while entering or leaving or being carried into or out of the said showground. Each competitor shall be responsible for the loss, injury or damage that may be done to or occasioned by, or arising from any animal, article or property, exhibited or brought onto the showground by him and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Rother Valley Riding Club from and against all actions, suits expenses and claims on account or in respect of any such damage or injury which may be caused or occasioned.
- All dogs to be kept on leads.
- Please clean up after your horse using skips provided.
- Health and Safety- Rother Valley Riding Club, the organisers of the events have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- No Horse or Pony may compete more than once in one class.
- Competitors being overtaken must give way.

No Stopwatches allowed, anyone seen using a stopwatch will be eliminated!**
