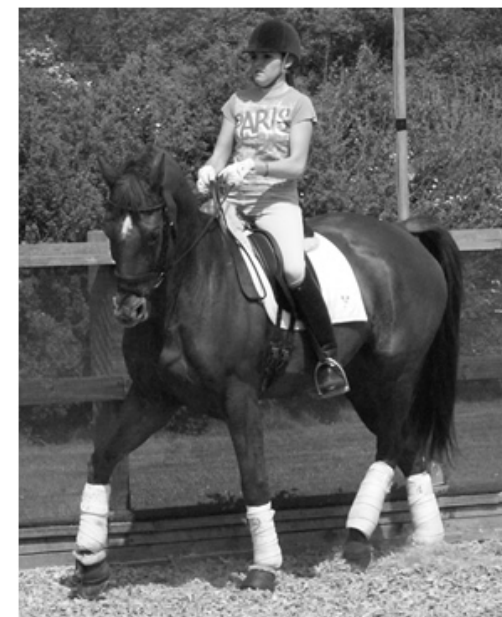

- ☺ Some class sizes may be restricted to around 15, depending on the venue, on a first come first served basis. Get your entries in early to be assured of a place.
- ☺ Classes will not start before 5pm and we have included a 'preferred time' on your entry form, we will try our best to keep to it!!!
- ☺ Entry fee £8 per class. Cheques to be made payable to RVRC. Entry fees will only be refunded on presentation of a vets or doctors certificate.
- ☺ Rosettes to 6th place. Special rosettes and a Sash for Winner of championship classes. There will also be a rosette for the highest individual percentage scored over the series, in both Open and Restricted sections across Prelim & Novice level i.e. one rosette for Restricted and one rosette for Open.
- ☺ Some refreshments available.
- ☺ Remember that these are private yards so please tidy up after you and your horse, thank you.

 - ☺ Entries close **8 days** before each show. Times will be posted on our website www.rvrc.org.uk. Or you can ring Jo for times on the Monday before the roadshow between 7-9pm 07803280533
 - ☺ Many of the Roadshows will also be a warm up for the dressage and Horse Trials teams. Entries will be limited so act quickly!
 - ☺ The HN01 class will qualify for the Novice Championship.
 - ☺ 1st-3rd will qualify for the championship roadshow which will be held during the day at Low Winter Farm(New Barn Farm), Rosemary Lane. If any of the first three have qualified at previous roadshows then the qualification will go to the next competitor down the line.
 - ☺ Please state clearly on the entry form which section you are in Open or Restricted:
- Restricted (R) (novice Section)**
- Riders not to be currently registered at affiliated level in British Dressage or British Eventing, including 'Day Ticket' entrants.
 - Riders that are qualified instructors or professional trainers must compete in the Open section.
 - Horse/Rider combinations that have come 1st in the restricted section in previous years roadshows, must move up to open section in that class. i.e. if you have won a prelim class in any previous roadshow, then you will now be in the open section for prelim class but may still compete at novice in restricted sections.
 - If you are in the restricted section at the beginning of the year you will stay in it for the whole season.
- Open (O) (OpenSection)**
- Open to all other riders.
