

300 yards up this road there will be a large yellow property set back on the right and our drive is the next turning on the right. It is not marked but is a tarmac drive which runs down next to 2 tile hung cottages that are right beside the road.

Class 1 BD INTRO A 2008 (walk and Trot)

Combination not to have won any British Dressage or Eventing points ever or come 1st in any prelim dressage comp

Class 2 Prelim 7 (2002)

Combination not to have been placed in a Novice test or above, Excluding RVRC dressage roadshows.

Section A Restricted: horse and/or rider not to have won any BD or BE points ever.

Section B: Open.

Class 3 Prelim 12 (2005)

Combination not to have been placed at Elementary level or above.

Section A Restricted: horse and/or rider, neither to have won any BD or

BE points ever.

Section B: Open.

Class 4 Novice 28 (2008)

Section A Restricted: horse and/or rider, neither to have won any BD or

BE points ever.

Section B: Open.

Class 5 Novice 34 (2009)

Section A Restricted: horse and/or rider, neither to have won any BD or

BE points ever.

Section B: Open.

Class 6 Elementary 44 (2002)

Open to all – go on, have a go!

Directions to the Show:

Follow the A21 past Lamberhurst, Flimwell, and into Hurst Green. At the end of the village is a pub on the right called the White Horse. Immediately opposite is a turning to Bodiam signposted Bodiam Casife and Bodiam. Follow that road through until you reach a large crossroads with a Pub called the Curlew on your left at the junction. Go straight over the crossroads following signs for Bodiam. After 2 bad bends you will go down a slight hill and see a primary school on the left. Turn left by the school signposted to Sandhurst. Please state on your entry form which section you wish to be in. If no section is chosen you will be entered in the Open section of the class. Restricted riders [R], are not to currently be registered with British Dressage or British Eventing, this includes day ticket entrants.

Riders that are qualified instructors or professional trainers must compete in the open [O] sections.

Rosettes to 6th place.
Separate rosettes will be given for each section.

Entry Fees: £10 per class for RVRC members.
£12 per class for non-members.

Trophies: We will have a points system running throughout the day and the Senior & Junior member with the most points at the end of the day will win a trophy. The more classes you enter the more chance of a trophy regardless of whether you were placed or not. Points as follows: 50-55%=4 points, over 55%-60%=6 points, over 60%-65%=8points, over 65% = 10 points. Rosette for the member with the highest percentage of the day.
