- ☺ All riders will be issued with a number (use your own bib) and you will ride in number order. Please report to steward at least 15mins before you are due to start. Class times are shown on schedule.
- ☺ Catering and a photographer will be on site for both days.
- ☺ The course will be fully decorated, just like Badminton!

- British Riding Club rules will apply.
