



Code of Conduct for All Club Members

- Learn the rules and ride within them.
- Set a good example by recognising fair competition and applauding good performances' of all, not just results.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Discourage unfair competition and arguing with officials.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Ensure that you keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- You are responsible for wearing suitable safety equipment and clothing – LIST COMPULSORY ITEMS – for training sessions and competitions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Any fees for training or competitions are paid promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or prohibited substances of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- When posting any photos on social media, please be aware of other members, competitors, volunteers or spectators in the background and check that they are happy for you to upload them.
- Under no circumstances will the Club tolerate any bullying, voicing of any forms of extremism or exploitation.
