Clinics and Instructors

*From 2 December 2020, BRC activities can resume across all Tiers. Whilst sporting activity is permitted to resume in all three Tiers, it should be noted that associated travel restrictions may govern what BRC activities can take place. As a general rule, people residing in Tier 1 can travel to Tier 2 but must comply with Tier 2 rules whilst there i.e. numbers allowed to meet. People residing in Tier 2 can travel to Tier 1 but must continue to comply with Tier 2 rules whilst there.

There should be no unnecessary travel into or out of Tier 3. BRC activities would not be considered necessary travel, so whilst events are permitted to be held in Tier 3 areas, they should only be attended by people residing within those areas. Organisers should do their best to enforce these travel restrictions, however it remains the ultimate responsibility of the individual.

Throughout the year RVRC put together clinics for members in all disciplines - these are advertised on both facebook, the RVRC website and emailed to members. Members can be entered through PlanitBookit.
